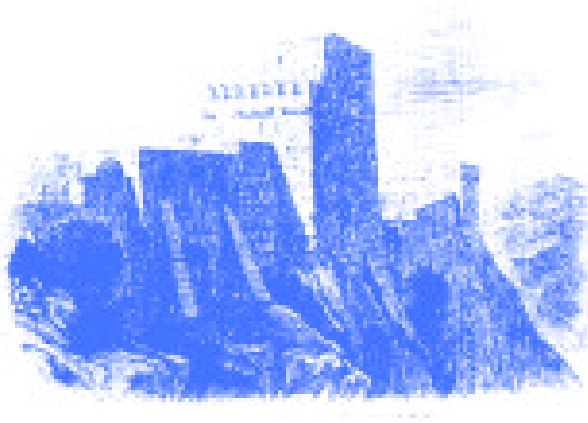


Terry and Ann Threadwell have been married for thirty years. They have three children and four grandchildren. Originally from England, they have been resident in the USA for the past twelve years. Both were ordained in England, and later transferred their credential over to the Church of God, out of Cleveland Tennessee. Terry is now an Ordained Bishop and an Endorsed Chaplain. Ann is an Ordained Minister, a Community Service Chaplain and currently an evangelist in Western North Carolina.

Thirteen years ago they were touring the eastern seaboard, preaching and teaching when they came to Charlotte to stay with friends. When they arrived, Oliver Raper was also staying. Oliver was at that time the European Director for Reinhardt Bonnke. They accepted an invitation to join Oliver and associates for a Fire Conference in Arlington Texas, where Reinhardt was ministering. At this conference Terry knew and told Ann that Reinhardt was going to pray for him. At the end of the conference Reinhardt prayed for Terry, that he would evangelize America. A powerful anointing came down and Terry shook from head to toe. On the return journey as they past through the foothills leading up the mountain, Ann made an exclamation, "We're home!" To their surprise God audibly replied, "Yes your home."

Nine months later they arrived back in Asheville, this time to stay. They began setting about planting a church. God had already prepared them and given them a vision for an urban ministry and the •City Church• was born. Whilst Terry was the teacher, Ann was the evangelist, hitting the streets, often going into drug and alcohol infested areas to spread the gospel. This was not new to them as they had spent several years in London doing the same thing. Over the next seven years they birthed many ministries that would inspire others to do the same. Various food programs, free medical clinic, Bible School and much more. They have preached in Russia, UK as well as within the USA.

Praxis

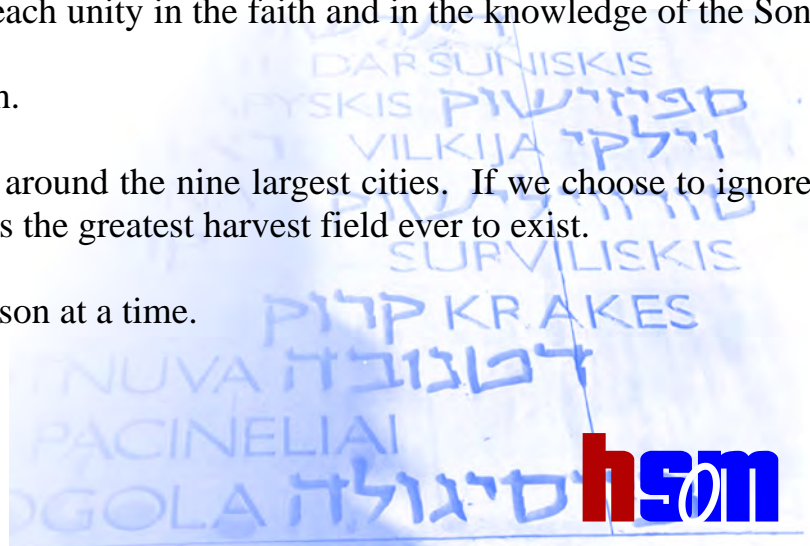
